

HAND & POWER TOOL SAFETY

Target Audience

This course is intended for staff who will be engaged in engineering, construction or demolition works requiring the use of hand and power tools.

Aims

The aim of this course is to provide participants with awareness of the regulations and safe working practices related to operating a range of Hand Held Electric Power Tools complying with manufacturer's instructions, thus aiding avoidance of injury within the workplace.

Content

- Develop an awareness of Health and Safety relating to hand tools and hand-held power tools.
- Use tools correctly and safely to recognised safety and manufacturer's instructions.
- Use appropriate methods of storage and maintenance as recommended by the manufacturer.
- The course is delivered in a classroom environment, with video and a representative selection of tools.

Assessment

Candidates are assessed by completion of a theoretical question paper.

Duration

This course is delivered over a half-day. An optional full-day course can be arranged for new-starts or less-experienced staff members. The additional session includes practical sessions on the correct selection, inspection and use of tools, and can be tailored to include tools specific to the client's workplace.
