

Confined Space Entry 2

Safe Entry into Confined Spaces (with Emergency Escape BA and Full Breathing Apparatus)

This course is designed for companies whose staff may be required to enter areas that are classified as confined spaces and where there may be a risk of serious injury or death.

The aim of the course is to provide awareness of the need for a safe working environment within a confined space, and to make staff aware of procedures to ensure safe access and egress from a confined space. and to have procedures in place in the event of an emergency whilst operators are working in a confined space. The course includes an introduction to the emergency procedures that must be in place in the event of a emergency arising whilst operators are working in a confined space. This course will include the Confined Space Regulations 1997 and other relevant Legislation.

Managers, supervisors, engineers and operatives will benefit from attendance on this course.

On successful completion of this course, the individual will be able to enter and work safely within confined spaces, using the necessary and appropriate equipment.
