

Confined Space Entry

Confined Space Entry Procedures (with Emergency Escape Breathing Apparatus)

The course is designed for companies whose staff may be required to enter areas that are classified as confined spaces and where there may be a risk of serious injury or death. The aim of this course will be to raise awareness of the need for a safe working environment within a confined space and to introduce staff to the procedures necessary to ensure safe access and egress from a confined space. The course includes an introduction to the emergency procedures that must be in place in the event of an emergency arising whilst operators are working in a confined space. This course will include the Confined Space Regulations 1997 and other relevant Legislation.

The course content is relevant to managers, supervisors, engineers and operatives.

On completion of the course the individual will be able to enter and work safely within confined spaces, using the necessary and appropriate equipment.

- Health and Safety Policy and Safe System of Work
- The Confined Space Regulations, Health and Safety at Work Act, Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, Personal Protection Equipment Regulations, Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations, Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) Regulations, Noise at Work Regulations
- Interpretation and recognition of confined spaces
- Safe working in confined spaces
- Use of permit to work procedures
- Plant and equipment, suitability and type
- Use of gas detection equipment
- Use of compressed air emergency escape breathing apparatus
- Use of Personal protective equipment
- Ventilation equipment
- Maintenance of PPE
- Daily Checks of equipment
- Monthly maintenance
- Manning levels
- Communication equipment and procedures
- Emergency procedures
